
























Ignite Legacy Update WINTER 2020



 Walnut Hill has joined with 30 other churches in CT and committed to cover one day each month in prayer so that there is continual prayer taking place for God's work in the state. Thank you to the 32 Walnut Hill congregants who have committed to make this possible.



- Adam DePasquale and Brian Prue continue to gather in prayer each month with six other pastors in northern Litchfield County. Great testimonies are being shared.
- On average, Walnut Hill provides support and encouragement to more than 20 churches and pastors each month.
- Walnut Hill is actively involved with 13 ministries in New England that are moving forward in ministry connected to prayer and worship, evangelism, discipleship, families, special needs, as well as fighting human trafficking and homelessness.



THE GLOBAL CHURCH IS ASKING FOR HELP

- Two teams recently returned having spent time encouraging global partners in Costa Rica and Bangladesh.
- Having been invited by World Relief to provide marriage support to pastors and their spouses in Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of Congo, a trip is being planned for June. More than 100 pastors and leaders will attend retreats and sessions led by Walnut Hill.
- Having been invited by Elam Ministries to train Iranian pastors and leaders, a trip is being planned for this spring.
- Additional opportunities are currently being assessed.



WE NEED TO PREPARE FOR FUTURE GUESTS

- Plans continue to move forward to purchase the property adjacent to the Bethel Campus in March.
- Planning is taking place to begin first stage renovations of bathrooms at the Waterbury Campus.
